### Changes to the Newsletter

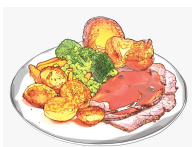

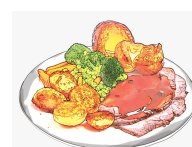
### Village Lunch
