
On Saturday 15th November 'In the Mood for Love'



Often listed as one of the greatest films of all time this romantic film follows two people who discover that their spouses are having an affair. As they spend time together, they gradually develop feelings for one another.


Doors open at 7pm and the film starts at 7.30pm.
